## Library Delivery: How Does it Work?

You can select your own materials, or library staff will work with you to select materials for delivery. Once your items have been chosen, the materials will be dropped off to you. Any items that you have ready to be returned to the library will be picked up at this time.

### Who Can Use This Service?

To be eligible for this service you must be a Hamden resident and unable to come to the library due to a permanent condition or a temporary condition lasting at least four weeks. Primary caregivers of homebound patrons will also be considered. For example, you may no longer be able to drive, have mobility problems, have a broken leg, or care for someone who is unable to be left alone.

### What Can I Expect From This Service?

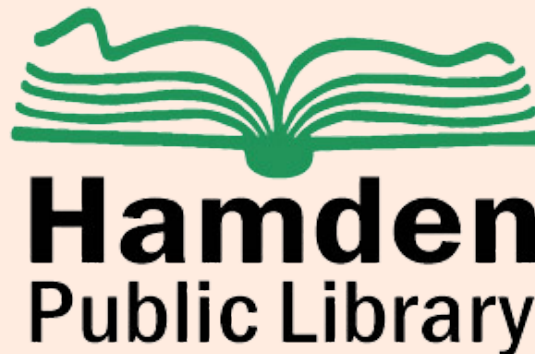
Once you have returned your completed application, a library staff member will contact you to answer questions and review your application. We will confirm your preferences at this time.
