APPLICATION FORM

Now in its thirty-ninth year, the Thornton Wilder Writing Competition (TWWC) was established by the Friends of Hamden Library to honor long-time Hamden resident and Pulitzer Prize winning author and playwright, Thornton Wilder. The competition is open to all New Haven County public, private, homeschool, and parochial high school students.

Competition Guidelines

- The competition is open to all students in grades 9-12, or the homeschool equivalent.
- Entrants must attend school in New Haven County.
- Students may submit up to one entry each for the fiction and poetry categories.
- Fiction entries can be short stories, scripts, plays, or excerpts from longer works.
- Entries may not exceed 2,500 words.
- Each submission must be accompanied by a completed application.
- All submissions are due by midnight on Sunday, February 23.

Submission Rules

Submission can be emailed, mailed, or delivered in person. We encourage students to email their submissions but understand that may not be possible for everyone. **All submissions are due by midnight on Sunday, February 23.** For more information, please visit hamdenlibrary.org/twwc.
